25 Years of CEW History on the Lakeshore

Back to the roots: 25 years ago a young couple from Iowa with two preschoolers felt called, out of a desire and need for community, to pursue a new concept for a retreat called Christian Experience Weekend (CEW) that they had attended in Dubuque Iowa. That brought them to the Holy Innocents parish counsel to gain approval to hold a weekend here. They were granted approval and were given \$75 in seed money to hold a CEW at Holy Innocents. They gave short talks describing CEW at all masses and made a request for folks who would be willing to attend a CEW in Iowa. Two men attended first followed by five women. Upon returning those who attended were on fire and decided, with the help of the Dubuque CEW community and some Marriage Encounter members a team could be gathered. Meetings were held, a can was passed at each meeting to pull together some more money to help finance the weekends. Discussions were held, teams picked, materials collected (mostly donated), cots were donated from Manitowoc County, showers were repaired in what was the old convent at the time(now the Life Teen House) and the stage was set for our first venture into CEW on the Lakeshore.
